


Figure 1. Generalized shell morphology.




Figure 2. Shell Shapes. a) elongate conic, b) elongate cylindrical, c) globose, d) depressed, e) discoidal




Figure 3. Shell sculpture.




Figure 4. Gastropod (Biomphalaria) internal anatomy.




Figure 5. Operculum types, showing position of nucleus. A. terminal; B. paucispiral; C. spiral.
